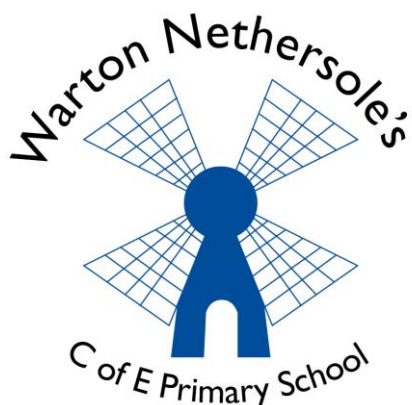

Statement on British Values
