

## Beech Home Learning

We understand that it might be difficult to work from home and carry out school work, so we have tried to make this list of ideas as flexible as possible.

Children are encouraged to practise their times tables daily, this could be through TT Rock Stars, Squeebles, or playing games both online and paper. Please practise the eight times tables in particular.

Classroom Secrets is a brand new site packed full of activities for children to use independently. These activities are maths, reading and grammar based, so cover a wide range of activities.

Following our class book 'The Bluest of Blues' we are asking children to research information on the main character Anna Atkins. They should research about her life and the things that she achieved and the drawings she made. Children can present their work in any way that they choose. This could be a poster or a leaflet. They might even have a go at sketching and drawing pictures similar to those of Anna! The choice is theirs, although we do ask that work is neatly presented so that we are able to display it in the classroom and share it with the class. As an extension to their work they could create a poem about the flowers or insects that Anna collected.

To tap into the children's creative side, children are encouraged to draw/paint/ sketch anything they are interested in. Children could create a poem, rap or song linked to something they enjoy. They could create their own book or comic. We look forward to seeing and hearing what the children have come up with!!

In science we are learning about different scientists and inventors. We are learning about Mary Anning a palaeontologist. They are to research and create a newspaper report based on the fossil she discovered. Children will understand how to set this out as this has been modelled in class.

There are lots of good websites / apps children are able to use for free. This will allow the children to work independently on a variety of subject areas.
