Expected Grammar Year 2

Children in year 2 are expected to use co-ordinating and subordinating conjunctions to join clauses. Co-ordinating conjunctions are used to link two phrases together as an equal pair eg. Kylie is young **but** she can kick the ball hard. Subordinating conjunctions introduce a subordinate clause (adding extra information) eg. Joe can't practise kicking **because** he's

Suffixes

Glue on the end of a word:

-ment	amazement
-ness	happiness
-ful	playful
-less	hopeless
-ly	angrily

Sometimes suffixes change the end of the root word.
