

Maple Home Learning

We understand that it might be difficult to work from home and carry out school work, so we have tried to make this list of ideas as flexible as possible.

* We are asking that children continue to read as much as possible, please record in home reading journal and complete as many reading activities as achievable.

* Children are encouraged to practise their times tables daily, this could be through TTRock Stars, Squeebles, or playing games both online and paper.

* Classroom Secrets <https://kids.classroomsecrets.co.uk/> is a brand new site packed full of activities for children to use independently. These activities are maths, reading and grammar based, so cover a wide range of activities.

* Following our class book 'One plastic Bag' we are asking children to chose a topic that interests them linked to this story. This could be researching Gambia, Plastic Pollution, ways to reuse plastic, learn to crochet etc ... Children can present their work in any way that they choose. this could be a poster or a leaflet. They might even have a go at making something from plastic! The choice is theirs, although we do ask that work is neatly presented so that we are able to display it in the classroom and share it with the class.

* To tap into the children's creative side, children are encouraged to draw/paint/ sketch anything they are interested in. Children could create a dance, poem, rap or song linked to something they enjoy. They could create their own book or comic. We look forward to seeing and hearing what the children have come up with!!

* In science we are learning about different scientists and inventors, children are encouraged to choose a scientist or inventor what has changed the world. They are to research and create a poster or leaflet showing what they have learnt about them and how they changed to world in which we live in today.

* There are lots of good websites / apps children are able to use for free. This will allow the children to work independently on a variety of subject areas.
