### Girls' Pearson Shield

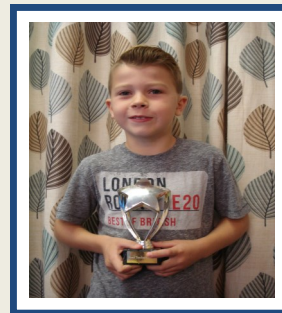
