### **KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE**

We have spoken to the children this week about keeping themselves safe at Halloween. In particular we have been asked by Trading Standards and RoSPA to highlight the potential dangers of Halloween costumes. Their advice is as follows:

See that the costume fits properly to avoid trips and falls

Always check costumes for a CE mark, instructions and safety information

Flames should be kept away from the child and costume, or use LED lights

Ensure any masks or hoods do not stop the child from seeing, or breathing
