We are aware of the concerns that many parents have around internet safety, and in particular the recent 'MOMO' phenomena which is popping up indiscriminately on children's sites.



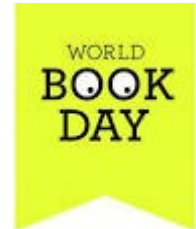
The Local Authority has assured us that there is no risk of children being exposed to this in school as our Firewall will block it.

KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE

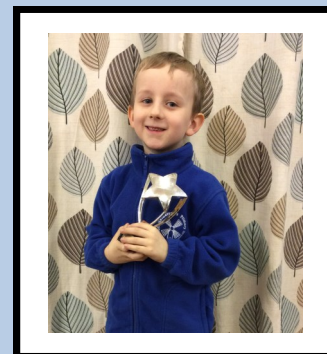
In spite of constant reminders about safe and courteous parking, we have once again been informed of a near miss incident in the layby, in front of school, in which children were nearly knocked over.
